

**EDA-I Vice Chairman Briefs
Leaderships and Senior Cadres of
EDP, ELF-RC and ENSF in Khartoum**

Mr. Mohammed Nur Ahmed, the provisional Vice Chairman of EDA-I, held a briefing session in Khartoum on 22 March 2007 for about 40 leadership members and senior cadres of the organizations that currently compose EDA-I on matters related to the crisis in the Eritrean opposition alliance.

The EDA-I Vice Chairman explained in great length the deliberations at the recent EDA congress and central council meetings held in Ethiopia and clarified how the crisis developed following a stiff resistance by the outgoing EDA chairman to withdraw his re-election candidature from the post he held for over two years.



In the briefing session, Mr. Mohammed Nur Ahmed was assisted by EDA central council members Woldeyesus Ammar and Haj Abdenur as well as Mahmoud Omar and Mohammed Adem Artaa, who represented their organizations in the last EDA congress.

The meeting participants discussed not only what went wrong in the alliance but also what action can be taken as of now by EDA-I members to revive and redouble the struggle against the dictatorship in Eritrea.

Mr. Mohammed Nur Ahmed and his EDA-I colleagues are also scheduled to address in Khartoum tomorrow, 23 March 2007, more members of the three allied organizations that make up EDA-I.
