

The EPP Executive Office Starts First Regular Meeting

The 17-member Executive Office of the Eritrean People's Party on 2 August 2008 held its first regular meeting after adopting items for the agenda. It meeting was chaired by Mr. Woldeyesus Ammar.

The meeting established Party organs like a Center for Studies and Research and later completed designating work teams in each of the 8 departments in the Executive Office each of which is made up of at least three members. There are departments which needed up to five members. Based on policy outlines drawn by the Central Council the other day, the Executive Office finalized reviewing and streamlining one-year work plans for the departments of Foreign Relations, Information and Culture, the Department for Political Education and Mobilization. Finalizing work plans will continue on 3 August 2008. On its part, the 9-person Secretariat of the Executive Office will eventually break up the work plans into 4-month that tasks expected to be achieved within the span of Secretariat meetings held every four months.

It is to be recalled that the 39-person Central Council held its last meeting on 1 August 2008 in which it elected officers who will be in charge of the Auditing and Supervision Unit which has two departments: one for financial auditing and the other for supervision of work performance and receipt/settlement of complaints. Mr. Gherezgher Tewolde was elected as Coordinator of this Unit whose other members are Mr. Tesfay Teklezghi and Zerabruk Ghebre-Tateyos.
