



Joint Statement

Eritrean People's Movement, Eritrean Democratic Party, and Eritrean People's Party Sub Branches of San Diego, California July 31, 2009

Members of Eritrean People's Movement (EPM), Eritrean Democratic Party (EDP), and Eritrean People's Party (EPP) in San Diego, California held a joint meeting on Wednesday, July 28, 2009 and discussed in-depth the recent joint unity agreement reached among their respective organizations.

Following extensive and detailed discussions on the agreement, members reached a joint understanding on the agreement, gave their strong support, and vowed to play active role to promote the cause until the final merger of the three organizations is fully achieved.
