

Eritreans Flee in Hundreds to Sudan

Eritreans continue to migrate to Sudan in hundreds every week to escape the clutches of the political tyranny of the Isayas regime. According to Eritrean People's Party sources, between July 4 and July 12, 2009, 449 Eritreans have crossed the Eritrean side border and arrived at the refugee camp of Shegerab, in Eastern Sudan.

The table below shows age and gender distribution of the new arrivals

In the past six months, the number of Eritreans who entered Shegerab refugee camp has reached 12,090. Since January of this year, every month an average of 2,000 Eritreans fled their country and entered Eastern Sudan.
