

80 Eritrean Refugees Resettled in Canada

After going through an extremely harrowing experience for a year and a half in Egyptian prison camps, 80 Eritrean refugees left Egypt at the end of last week and resettled in Canada, Eritrean People's Party source reported. It is a great relief for many of these Eritreans to start a new life in Canada after suffering a wide range of human rights violation during their stay in Egypt.

There are hundreds of Eritrean refugees still living in two prison camps in Egypt under inhumane conditions that need to resettle in third countries. We call on UNHCR and other refugee agencies to make every effort to find resettlement countries for the remaining Eritrean refugees where they could start new life and find protection and freedom.

Eritrean People's Party will continue as before to bring the plight of Eritrean refugees in Egyptian prison camps to the attention of UNHCR and other agencies.
